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Welcome readers, to the March/April edition of the Tattler. Already into the 3rd month of the vear and the fast pace is continuing. In this edition we will be focusing on the current state of our building project, where we are up to and what to expect over the next few months.

Our Memory Support Houses are all but complete with handover expected in the first week of March. At the time of writing this report the landscaping and fencing is under way. Painting and joinery is being finalized, floor covering is being laid (check out the photos from Kate)

Once the houses are completed, we will be concentrating on the other components of the project. These components include:

- upgrade to the Lodge kitchen and dining room. This will provide an extended washup area in the kitchen as well as a renovated well-appointed dining room.
- Converting the Lodge Wing 2 into a link to the new houses. The link which we have named "Southbrook" will include a chapel/reflection room as well as an activities and theatre room.
- Renovation of the rooms in the Lodge wings 1, 8 and 9. During this work some of our existing residents will transfer temporarily to the new houses.
- Upgrade of the administration offices, providing improved functionality and an expanded meeting and education room,
- Upgrade of the laundry,
- Development the Wellness Centre including relocation of our gym.

While completion of the new houses is the major milestone, there is still significant work to complete in these other areas. The total project should be completed by August 2020. As always, we are endeavouring to keep any disruption to a minimum.

If you would like to know more or express an interest in residency of the new houses, please contact us.

In other news we are excited to announce that we are again sponsoring the Empire Theatre's Daytime Series. Our involvement in these events establishes our name as an innovative leader in aged care looking beyond the fundamental model of residential care to that of a wellness and lifestyle model. So watch out for the dates and any ticket giveaways that might be happening. The first show for the season was on the 20 February. Check inside this edition for all the action.

We want to thank all our residents and families for their patience and support over the last 6 months of building activity. I know we are all looking forward to its completion.

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

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
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

DRIVE THROUGH



Along with the new Aged Care Quality Standards that came into effect from 1st July 2019 (seen on next page) a new **Charter of Aged Care Rights** has been released for all aged care services. Both of these new legislative documents form part of an exciting shift towards greater consumer involvement and choice within the aged care industry.



Beauaraba Living, along with all other aged care providers, must give consumers (residents) a copy of the new Charter signed by the provider, and ensure that the consumer (resident) or their authorised person has been given a reasonable opportunity to sign a copy of the Charter.

The purpose of requesting the consumer's signature is to allow them to acknowledge they have received the Charter, had assistance to understand it and understand their rights. Consumers (Residents) are not required to sign the Charter and can commence, and/or continue to receive care and services, even if they choose not to sign the Charter. All residents and/or their representatives will be contacted by Beauaraba Living over the coming months to ensure this legislative requirement is met. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact us via the Administration Office.

Charter of Aged Care Rights

I have the right to:

- 1. safe and high quality care and services
- 2. be treated with dignity and respect
- 3. have my identity, culture and diversity valued and supported
- 4. live without abuse and neglect
- 5. be informed about my care and services in a way I understand
- 6. access all information about myself, including information about my rights, care and services
- 7. have control over, and make choices about, my care, personal and social life, including where choices involve personal risk
- 8. have control over, and to make decisions about, the personal aspects of my daily life, financial affairs and possessions
- 9. my independence
- 10. be listened to and understood
- 11. have a person of my choice, including an aged care advocate, support me or speak on my behalf
- 12. complain free from reprisal, and to have my complaints dealt with fairly and promptly
- 13. personal privacy and to have my personal information protected
