As we publish this edition of the Tattler we find ourselves in unprecedented times. Changes in the way we conduct ourselves socially and commercially are happening every day. These changes will be part of a new normal when the COVID-19 crisis eventually abates.

Within our facility all of our staff performing above and beyond to keep our residents safe and engaged. In the overwhelming majority of cases resident families have been totally supportive of the actions we have had to take for the safety of not just our residents but also our staff and the wider community. On Behalf of board, the team here Beauaraba Living as well as the residents, I would like to thank you for your cooperation and patience during these difficult times.

We will continue to keep you informed of any changes as they arise. Please be assured that we are following guidelines as provided by the federal and state health authorities as well as advice from our industry body, Leading Aged Services Australia (LASA). Our Board of Directors continues to function although remotely to keep abreast of operational and Governance requirements in our current situation.

Please remember, according to Government legislation, as from 1 May 2020 unless you have had your 2020 flu vaccination you WILL NOT be permitted to enter the facility. The only exception to this will be on medical grounds. Documented evidence will be required. This includes residents and staff.

On an exciting and positive note we have managed to continue with building program by applying strict separation procedures with our building contractors to ensure the safety of our residents. As many of you already know our 26 bed extension – Brookstead and Pampas Houses - is now complete and we have transferred as well as admitted new residents over the last two weeks. Unfortunately given the current restrictions we have been unable to showcase this new building for the community. Hopefully when all the restrictions are lifted we may be able to allow small groups from the community to inspect this wonderful new addition to our facility.

He have applied and have been successful in bringing 22 provisional bed allocations online. This means we have government approval to provide care in 128 beds.

The completion of the new wings is only part of the extensive refurbishments we are undertaking. The work that is underway now is the renovations of several wings in the Lodge building. The remaining work will be an upgrade to the Lodge kitchen and dining room, expansion of our laundry, an upgrade to our administration offices and the development of our Wellness Centre. We will continue to keep you informed as this work progresses.

In other news, we celebrated Anzac Day, as did all Australians in a very different way this year. See photos inside. Also, a very tall Easter Bunny visited our facility and was seen skipping through the corridors with cheery hellos and chocolates for our residents.

In the meantime, check out the latest building photos and resident activities, including our Easter celebrations, in this edition. Also please keep an eye out for our **CORONANEWS** newsletter where we keep you updated with the latest developments around COVID 19 restrictions and guidelines.







At least I've got a stash of booze For when I'm being idle There's wine and whiskey, even gin If I'm feeling suicidal!


So let's all drink to lockdown To recovery and health And hope this awful virus Doesn't decimate our wealth.

We'll all get through the crisis And be back to join our mates Just hoping I'm not far too wide To fit through the flaming gates!








Along with the new Aged Care Quality Standards that came into effect from 1st July 2019 (seen on next page) a new **Charter of Aged Care Rights** has been released for all aged care services. Both of these new legislative documents form part of an exciting shift towards greater consumer involvement and choice within the aged care industry.



Beauaraba Living, along with all other aged care providers, must give consumers (residents) a copy of the new Charter signed by the provider, and ensure that the consumer (resident) or their authorised person has been given a reasonable opportunity to sign a copy of the Charter.

The purpose of requesting the consumer's signature is to allow them to acknowledge they have received the Charter, had assistance to understand it and understand their rights. Consumers (Residents) are not required to sign the Charter and can commence, and/or continue to receive care and services, even if they choose not to sign the Charter. All residents and/or their representatives will be contacted by Beauaraba Living over the coming months to ensure this legislative requirement is met. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact us via the Administration Office.

Charter of Aged Care Rights

I have the right to:

- 1. safe and high quality care and services
- 2. be treated with dignity and respect
- 3. have my identity, culture and diversity valued and supported
- 4. live without abuse and neglect
- 5. be informed about my care and services in a way I understand
- 6. access all information about myself, including information about my rights, care and services
- 7. have control over, and make choices about, my care, personal and social life, including where choices involve personal risk
- 8. have control over, and to make decisions about, the personal aspects of my daily life, financial affairs and possessions
- 9. my independence
- 10. be listened to and understood
- 11. have a person of my choice, including an aged care advocate, support me or speak on my behalf
- 12. complain free from reprisal, and to have my complaints dealt with fairly and promptly
- 13. personal privacy and to have my personal information protected
